

Saanich Peninsula Parish Cemetery Committee Annual Report June 2010

From June 2009 - June 2010-06-08

The Committee currently consists of two volunteers. One looks after allocation of plot reservations, contracts, bookkeeping, reporting, forms and liaison with the families, the Parish Office and the Pastor. The second locates and marks plots and digs cremation plots as required if the family is not able.

Funding for the maintenance of the Cemetery comes from fees for reserving the right to be interred in a plot, and fees for marking and digging as well as interest from a GIC.

The BC Government now requires a contract signed by the purchaser and the representative of the Committee for the reservation of plots. We are using these contracts with new purchases, and we are gradually arranging meetings with those who have previously made reservations to deal with this formality.

In this time period:

- 1 full burial plot has been reserved.
- 16 cremation plots have been reserved.
- 5 cremated remains have been interred.
- 5 full burial plot reservations have been cancelled.

We would be happy to meet with anyone interested in learning more about this Ministry.
